

# He Shares his Life with you

A326 Sunday Address 13th March 1960 New Lands, Liss Sunday Service

*Text:* carbon typescript, probably by AMI. No markings.

*Context:* the service on 13 March was advertised in *Stella Polaris* simply as a service of worship and communion, so White Eagle's message is an 'extra', given after the person who led the service had finished. Between the opening and the closing comments it is simply a communion.

*General Notes:* The communion is unusual in that the members of the congregation are asked in their imagination to come forward one by one to receive; invariably, otherwise, they just see the Master before them. The phrase, 'He shares his life with you' is also unusual.

*References:* 'And the peace of God, which passeth all worldly understanding' may be quoted from Philippians 4 : 7, but more likely from the Book of Common Prayer.

## White Eagle's Address:

We speak to you from that world of spirit about which you have been hearing, and we assure you that all around you in this service is a company of the White Brotherhood, and in the silence of your own heart we trust you will accept from the Master, the Lord Jesus the Christ, whose presence is here in your midst – from him accept in your heart the communion with him which he offers you now from a world of higher ether, a spirit world. He holds the vision for *you*, that you may see him in the golden radiance of the temple above. He stands by the communion table. Now look and see the bread upon the golden plate and the golden cup of wine.

Individually come towards him in your spirit and accept from him this heavenly bread, the symbol of life, food given to the spirit. Take; eat; remembering him....

Now he holds for you the golden cup filled with the divine essence, the essence of love. Sip this wine and you will know that you are close, close to him, and you will realise the presence of your own dear ones in spirit ... and the company of shining White Brethren.... And he blesses you and says that he shares his life with you. Amen. Amen. Amen.

Beloved brethren, the proof of a life beyond death is within yourself. You will not receive a finer, a greater proof of life after death than you will receive in your own soul when you rise in consciousness and see for yourselves that glorious life. No man can give you the proof which will remain always. It must be born in your own soul through reaching up *yourself* to touch that higher level of conscious spiritual life.

And so we leave you with all love, all love, and all your needs, both material, physical, spiritual will be supplied by that divine love of your Creator. And may the peace which passeth all worldly understanding rest with you always. Amen.
